## Tournament Rules

- **Coaches must bring player birth certificates or proof of age to the tournament.**
  - **All teams must wear numbered uniforms**
  - **First team listed will be the home team wearing light jerseys and should sit to the left of the scorer's table.**
  - Locker rooms will be provided.
  - The Head Coach is responsible for attending to the medical needs of his/her athletes.
  - The Head Coach is responsible for the conduct of his/her coaches, players, and fans.
  - Referees and the tournament director hold the right to ask anyone to leave for improper behavior.
  - No protests will be accepted.
  - **Home team will supply game ball (unless otherwise agreed by coaches).**  
**4<sup>TH</sup>, 5<sup>TH</sup> AND 6<sup>TH</sup> will use 28.5 size ball**  
7<sup>TH</sup> GRADE and older will use regulation size ball.
  - Tie Breaker: 1<sup>st</sup> – head to head competition.  
We use a Computer system which figures out Ties where teams have the same records.
  - **Home team will provide the official scorer and score book.** If conflict with score book, both home and visitors book will be brought together and resolved by the head referee.
  - **Visiting team will provide the official timekeeper and will run the clock.**
  - Arrive at the gym ready to play 45 minutes before your scheduled time. Gyms will open 30 minutes before the first game on Saturday and Sunday mornings.
  - Playing time will be. **12 minute halves for 4<sup>TH</sup> 5<sup>th</sup>; 14 minute halves for 6<sup>th</sup>; 16 minute halves for 7<sup>th</sup> and above.** We will have 5 minutes between games and 5 minute half times.
  - Two time outs per half. Timeouts do not carry over.
  - The first overtime will be (2) minutes. All overtimes thereafter will be one (1) minute. There will be one (1) timeout per overtime period.
  - **The slaughter rule will be in effect (30 point lead with four minutes left in the game); clock will run until team cuts it to 20. A team may not press after obtaining a 20 point lead.**
  - There will be a short ceremony following each championship game.
  - Team Trophy and individual awards will be presented to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place teams
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- We may mix age divisions if we don't have enough teams to complete a division. If this is done we will not mix more than (1) age division. We will also notify you than this was done so you can adjust your roster if you want.
